2016 Board Objectives

Priority A

- Maintain County's financial stability and core services in light of economic conditions.
- Prioritize the implementation of existing County policies and programs to reduce the risk of wildfire and the effects of wildfire on life, property and the environment.
- Work with our legislative advocates to introduce flexibility with rural counties in the housing element policy. Create opportunities for additional workforce and senior housing units.
- Ensure the Public Library's continued sustainability with a replacement voter approved sales tax measure to follow Measure C when it expires in 2018.

Priority B

- Support job-enhancing economic development efforts where appropriate.
- Support permanent housing community efforts to reduce homelessness by working in coordination with the Continuum of Care, enhancing supportive services, and following evidenced based practices.
- Pursue a funding plan and the construction of a new corporation yard which consolidates transit, fleet and roads maintenance onto one site at the Bear River Mills property. Explore economic development options for the current yard (Lot 6) when vacated which may include Airport expansion, commercial development and/or other best use opportunities.
- Work with RCRC, CSAC and Nevada County legislative advocates to identify and seek Cap and Trade funds that can be applied for by Nevada County.

Priority C

- Assist water agencies as requested during this drought as appropriate.
- Re-evaluate the County's sphere policies.
- Increase public awareness and civic engagement through educational information programs.
- Evaluate the options and feasibility of establishing a Business License process in the County.
- Rezone Forest Service properties to be consistent with Forest Service objectives.
- Investigate criteria for Disadvantaged Unincorporated Communities (DUC) to increase infrastructure and service needs.
- Investigate the feasibility of a Municipal Advisory Committee (MAC) for Nevada County.
