The Veterans Building is a beautiful venue that is shared by the community for fundraisers, children's groups, dances and proms, musical concerts and theatrical productions, meetings, dinners, weddings, reunions and anniversaries. Several veterans groups, including the American Legion, Disabled American Veterans, Vietnam Veterans and the Marine Corps League, use the building for their meetings and special events.
