The following procedures shall be in effect with regard to the public's exercise of this right: 1) The total amount of time allotted for receiving such public comment may be limited to not less than 15 minutes during any regular Commission meeting. 2) The chairman may limit any individual to not less than 3 minutes. Time to address the Commission will be allocated on a basis of the order of requests received. Not all members may be allowed to speak if the total time allocated expires. At special meetings of the Commission, public comment will only be allowed on matters appearing on the agenda
