All services and contacts with the public are confidential.

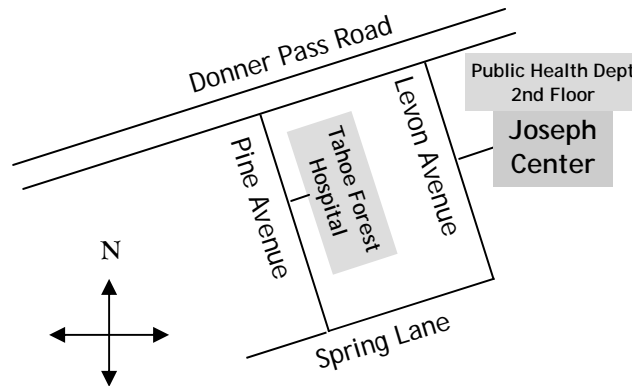
GENERAL INFORMATION

MATERNAL CHILD AND ADOLESCENT HEALTH (MCAH)
