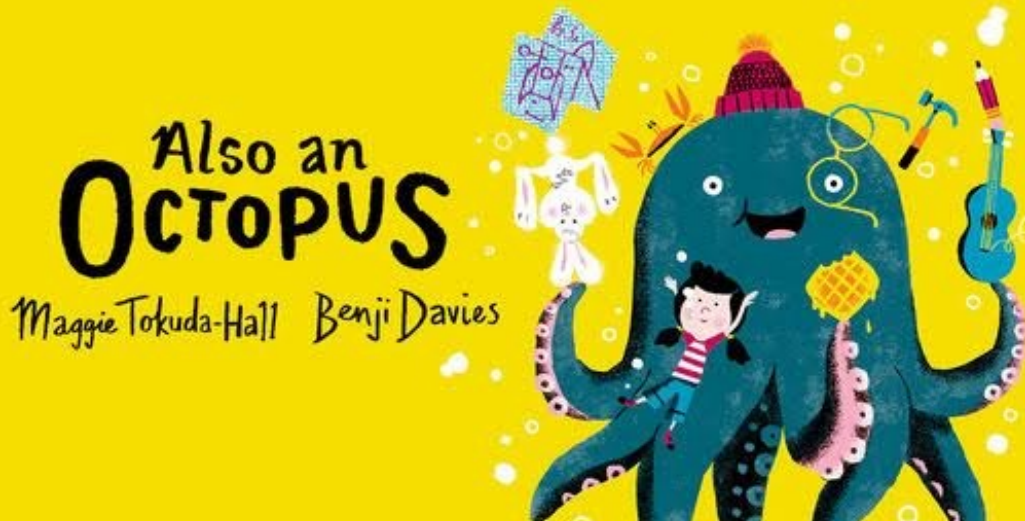


Celebrate Children's Book Week and Screen-Free Week with the Library!
