Next Steps

To protect yourself and others, wear a mask.



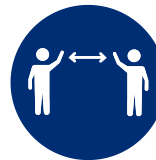
Isolate if You're Sick

Stay away from others if you have symptoms.



Wash Your Hands

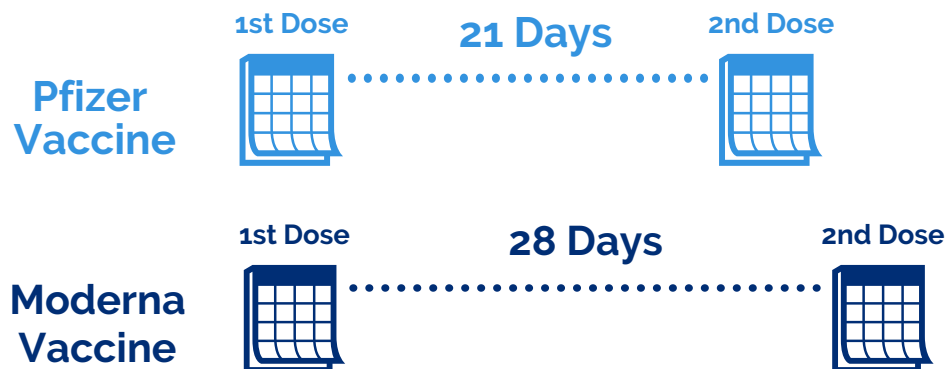
Wash your hands often.



Keep Your Distance

Stay six feet from people not in your household.

Schedule your second shot. The first shot is just the start. Make sure you get your second dose for full protection. If you received the Pfizer vaccine, your second shot should be in 21 days. If you received the Moderna vaccine, your second shot should be in 28 days.
